When can I collect my A Level/BTEC/Cambridge Technicals/other Year 12 results?

Thursday 15 August
9.00am to 11.00am
Main Hall

What about GCSE re-sit results?

Thursday 22 August
10.00am to 12.00pm
Main Hall

Can someone collect my results for me?

Yes. Before Results Day we require your written permission to release your information to a third party (permission slip at the end of this document). The person collecting your results must bring proof of identity; if they do not, we can't release your results.

Can my results be posted home?

Yes. Please send the permission slip (at the end of this document) to enable us to post your results. We can't email them.

I've applied for university. What happens next?

On the morning of Results Day you can log in to UCAS Track to see the updated status of your offer.

You will be in one of the following situations:

Conditions of offer met – if you achieve the grades you needed for your firm choice, your Conditional Firm (CF) will become an Unconditional Firm (UF) choice. If you did not meet the grades for your firm choice but did meet the conditions for your insurance choice then your Conditional Insurance (CI) will become Unconditional Insurance (UI). You will automatically be placed at your insurance if you met those requirements but not those of your firm choice.

Conditions of offer not met – changed course offer - sometimes if you don't quite meet the offer of your firm choice they may offer you a slightly different course - this is shown on Track. You may wish to accept this offer but you are not obliged to do so immediately, you have five days to decide. If you decline you will be placed in your insurance choice, or if they decline you will move automatically into clearing. Please see a member of the sixth form team on Results Day if this is the case, especially if you are uncertain about accepting a changed course offer.

Conditions of offer not met - Clearing – this is available for those learners who didn't meet their Conditional Firm (CF) or Conditional Insurance (CI) offers. If you are eligible for Clearing you will see a message at the top of your offers screen. See the link below for more about how Clearing works.

Conditions of offer met - Adjustment – If you exceed the grades needed for your Conditional Firm (CF) choice then the Adjustment scheme may be available to you. This is where you are given five days to find an alternative place if you wish to do so. The option to register will be displayed if you are eligible. In the meantime, your Conditional Firm (CF) choice will become your Unconditional Firm (UF) and you will still receive confirmation from your firm choice. Please speak to a member of the Sixth Form Team on Results Day if you are given this option and see the link below for more detail.
