One of the aspects of this national initiative is the requirement of schools to make milk available for all students at least once during the school day. Our catering partner, Innovate has ensured that milk has been available for students to purchase at both break and lunch times since the start of the new term. There is also a requirement for those students claiming free school meals to be allowed to have milk at either break or lunch time free of charge. If a student claiming free school meals makes a purchase of milk, our school information management system alerts the till operator, without drawing attention to the student, so that they are not charged. Students on free school meals will not be given milk automatically; it is for all students to ask for milk for which they will be either charged or not.
