Dear Parent/Carer

Re: Key Stage 3 Sports Day – Friday 15 July 2022

We are delighted that once again we can host our Key Stage 3 Sports Day, which this year is to be held on Friday 15 July 2022. Members of staff have been making preparations for the organisation of the day and our children have been participating in events during their PE lessons to be as prepared as possible for the big day!

Sports Day is an annual event held for all pupils in Years 7, 8 and 9. All pupils in these year groups should be in school at the usual time of 8.50am and are expected to bring their usual school equipment, e.g., planner and pens as the first part of the day will be an extended form period. All pupils in Years 7, 8 and 9, will participate in Sports Day and to ensure a smooth start to the activities your son/daughter should wear their PE kit to school.

If there has been rain the day before, resulting in the racing tracks not being usable or if on the day there is rain, the timetable for all year groups will be in place and lessons will be as usual. As there is no guarantee of the weather, in case of cooler weather, pupils might want to bring a jacket to wear when they are not taking part in activities; in the event of hot weather, we recommend pupils bring sunblock and a full bottle of water, which they will be able to refill during the day. Personal belongings will be locked in form rooms although our advice is that pupils do not bring high value items into school.

Lunchtime will be 12.25 to 12.55 and the Innovate catering team will provide lunch as usual with the addition of a barbecue style lunch, cooked indoors, with burgers and salad as an option; pupils are able to still bring a packed lunch.
