The exam board is Pearson.

There is one exam: a 2 hour paper which will be completed in Y11, this will take place on the 7th May 2024.

All pupils must have taken the exam; they cannot achieve a final grade without doing so. There are two units of work that are assessed by a PSA (Pearson Set Assignments).

Each unit has five tasks that must be completed. Each task goes towards achieving a Pass, Merit or Distinction grade for the unit.

Unit 1: Human Lifespan Development. The PSA for this was completed in May 2023. Pupils who missed this assessment will need to complete this in January 2024. Assessment packs will be issued in November.

Unit 2: Health and Social Care Services and Values. This PSA must be completed by 8th December. The PSA will take place in lessons. If pupils miss those lessons, they must arrange to catch up with their main teacher.

All pupils have a tracker sheet that records what they have achieved so far and a guide to working out the grade they are currently working at. This also shows the grade combinations needed across different units to achieve their target grade or better.

Pupils must ensure that all notes are up to date in their exercise books. If a lesson is missed, pupils are responsible for catching up on the missed work – ensure you see your teacher to arrange this.
