

TRAVEL CODE OF CONDUCT FOR PUPILS

Waiting

Queue sensibly away from the road/platform edge
Get on board calmly without pushing.

On board

Show your MyBus pass/permit to the driver or pay the correct fare
Find a seat and stay seated for the journey
Fasten your seatbelt
Do not distract the driver unless in an emergency
Show respect to the driver, conductor and other passengers
Follow all staff instructions
Do not damage, graffiti or leave litter
Do not eat, smoke or drink
Always behave sensibly
Never touch the emergency exit or play with emergency equipment – it saves lives
Never leave your bag in the aisle or block doors.

Getting off

When your stop is next ring the bell once. If it has already been rung you do not need to ring it again
If you have to cross the road, wait until the bus has moved off and you can see the road clearly in both directions or go to the nearest available crossing
If travelling by train be safe on the platform and do not cross the tracks.

My Bus

In accepting your MyBus pass you undertake to accept the terms and conditions of travel. You need to be aware that if you cause damage or do not meet the required standard of behaviour on the bus you could:

- Have your MyBus pass withdrawn
- Be banned from the bus
- Be prosecuted by the police
- Be required to pay for any damage you have caused.
