



Dear Parents/Carers,

Transition Day – Wednesday 1st July 2026

We look forward to meeting new pupils for a full day of activities at our school on Wednesday 1st July, giving pupils an opportunity to spend time with staff and their new peers before their start in September. Pupils will take part in taster lessons to give them an insight into what school life at Titus Salt School feels like. Pupils will be placed in their new form groups for this day and will spend the day together. They will spend some time during the day with their form tutor, who will help support them in their journey at TSS. The form group will be a mixture of children of all abilities and primary schools.

Arrangements for the day:

- Pupils should arrive at TSS for **8.40am**, to our community gate entrance – this is on the lower level at the bottom of the stairs below reception, next to the staff car park. Pupils will be directed to the main hall to register.
- Pupils should come straight to TSS. They do not need to attend their primary school first. We will inform primary schools of pupil attendance.
- Pupils should wear their current school uniform.
- Pupils should bring a packed lunch for the day. They should also bring a refillable (named) water bottle which can be filled around school.
- Please be aware, there will be no access for pupils to buy additional items on site on this day.
- The day will finish at **2.40pm** and pupils can be collected at that time. Pupils will exit through our main doors next to reception. Parents/carers may decide to either collect their child from our site or allow them to make their own way home. It is important that you ensure your child is aware of your individual arrangements for the end of the day, for example: if they need to walk down and meet you in the car park or meet you outside reception. Pupils will be able to wait in our cafe area for older siblings if they are going home together.

Parent/Carer Information Evening – Thursday 2nd July 2026

As a school we strive to work together with parents/carers to support a smooth transition to our school for your child. A short presentation will be held for new parents/carers in the Main Hall on Thursday 2nd July 2026. You will be introduced to key members of TSS staff who will share information about our school, so together we can support your child in a successful start in Year 7. Members of the Year team, Transition team, SEND team, RP team and CIC team will be present. The evening is for parents/carers only. Pupils should not attend.

Following the presentation in our main hall, you will visit your child's form room and meet their form tutor. Tutors will share information about their role and how this will support your child in their time at our school.

SEND information session – for those who have a child currently on the SEND register, there will be a session available for you to attend after you have met form tutors. Our SEND team will share information about how we support pupils at TSS.

PE ¼ Zip tops - we will have some good quality second hand ¼ zip PE tops available to purchase on the evening. We are asking for a £3 cash donation towards our PE department for these. If you think you might be interested, please bring along £3 cash.

To help us in managing the numbers of parents/carers who attend this evening we have organised two identical presentations and ask that, if possible, you book on to one of the following presentations.

- Session 1 – Arrive from 4.30pm for a 5.00pm start
- Session 2 – Arrive from 5.30pm for a 6.00pm start

Family Transition Week 6-9th July

At Titus Salt School, we are keen to develop a culture of belonging to our school community, not just for our pupils, but for their parents/carers as well. Our school strives to be a place where we work together to ensure the best possible opportunities, outcomes and enrichment for our children and to do this, we want to work closely with you. To help smooth the transition of your child, and yourself, into our community we are launching our first ever Family Transition Week this year, from Monday 6th to Thursday 9th July.

On each day, from 3:30pm to 4:30 pm, there will five workshops that your child can opt into for free. We want our parents/carers to be fully involved in these lessons alongside the children!
