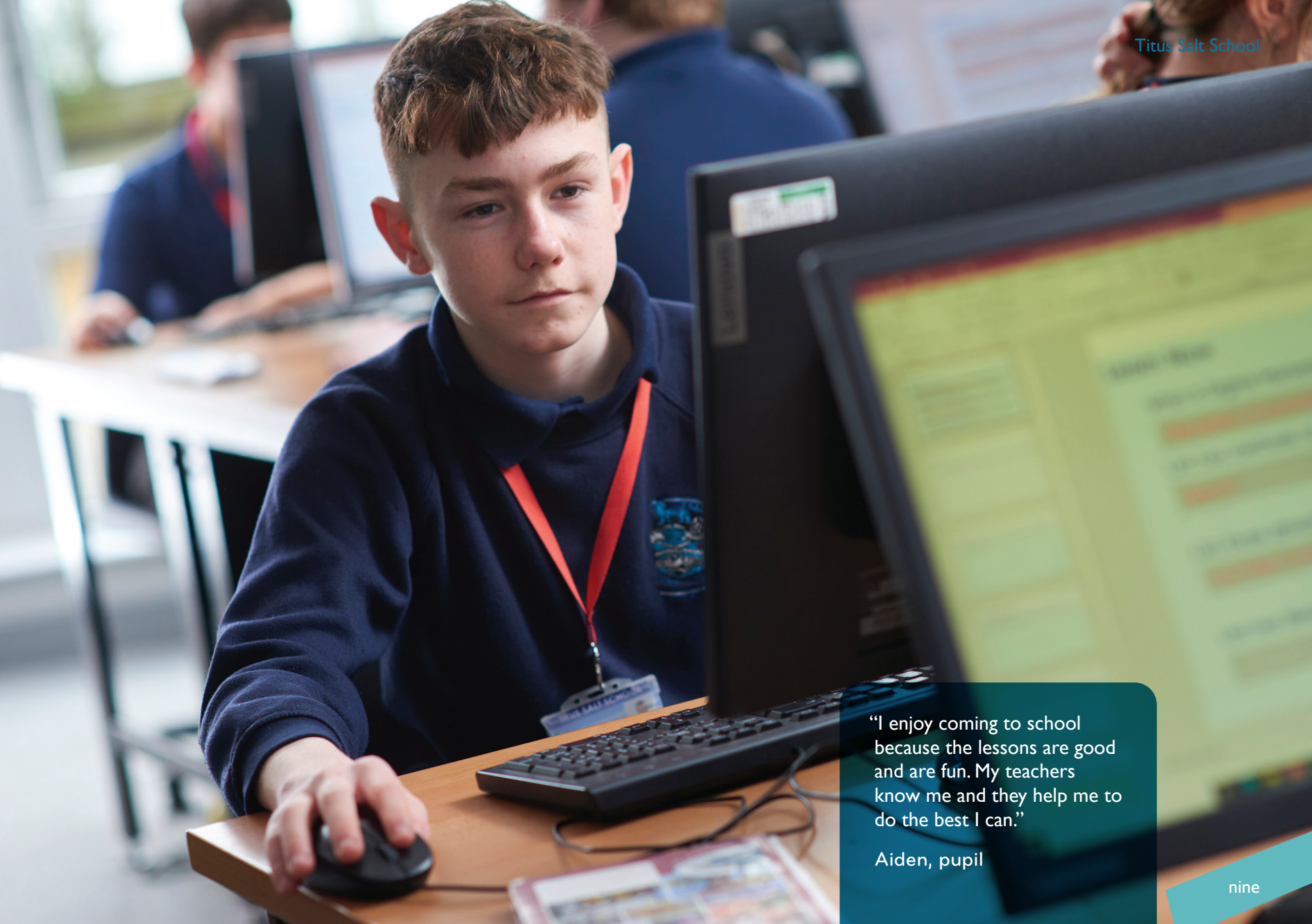
Inspire

The school reflects our ethos – open, friendly and ambitious with care and safe-keeping at the heart of what we do.

The approach to teaching and learning centres around our core values: with caring teachers pupils work together to develop the resilience needed to achieve ambitious outcomes. Teachers know each pupil individually and adapt learning so that it is challenging for all. We have a broad and balanced spiral curriculum where concepts are revisited and understanding strengthened as pupils progress through the school, with an emphasis on adapting to celebrate the strengths and interests of all while still securing key foundational knowledge in a broad range of subjects. Teachers use regular low stakes assessments, including home learning tasks, to support pupils in remembering what they have been taught and to help them understand their next steps to make good progress. Pupils are encouraged to take ownership of their learning and to show pride in their achievements.

We aim to inspire pupils as they, in turn, inspire us with what they know and can do. From visiting speakers, workshops, teams events, trips to galleries, museums, other countries - Titus Salt School is where pupils can explore new opportunities and discover for themselves that together we are resilient, ambitious and caring.
